PLATES

The Oka 'Taphuban Porcelain Plates' on the kitchen worktop feature a design adapted from traditional Peruvian patterns. Their distinctive floral motifs in blue, red and green are characteristic of Inca pottery, named for the Andean town where it was made until the seventeenth century. They measure 30cm in diameter and cost £200 for a set of four designs. oka.com



LIGHTING

Vaughaan's 'Polaris Star' wall lights hang on either side of the bed in one of the spare rooms. The design is inspired by French art deco pieces from the 1920s and features a star-shaped crystal backplate on a nickel base. Available with one or two arms, this double-arm version measures 20.2 x 22 x 18cm and costs from £499. vaughandesigns.com



FABRICS

Przy used a range of fabrics in the flat, including vintage finds and some of her own designs. The headboard in one of the spare rooms is upholstered in a vintage Saxon fabric that she bought in Istanbul; for a similar look, try Sanderson's 'Athos' (1) in red/indigo, £91 a metre. The drawing-room blinds are in 'Cubloose', a linen mix in brown/natural (2) from Hillfield, costing £90.50 a metre, which perfectly complements the soft pink of the walls. Przy used her own 'Ticking Stripe Ocean' (3) on the banquette in the kitchen; a reversible cotton mix, it costs £174 a metre. Another of her fabrics, the pretty floral linen 'Latika' (4), £270 a metre, covers the walls in the pink bedroom and has been used for the blind and the cushions.



COFFEE TABLE

The antique glass and brass table in the centre of the drawing room is in the style of Paris design house Maquet Jansen, a company founded in 1880 whose designs inspired many high-end furniture makers throughout the twentieth century. This table from Latifah is very similar. It measures 80 x 127 x 60cm and costs £1,650. latifahinteriors.com



CERAMICS

The Chinese porcelain duck given on the dining table is thought to be an early nineteenth-century piece. For something similar, keep an eye on the stock at Andrew Tuttle. andrewtuttle.co.uk
