The Mathilde Commode

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Contemporary serpentine-front mango wood commode with 1940s/50s American paper - wonderful shape modelled on an 18th century European design. The commode is hand crafted, and the paper is carefully hand-sanded to give a distressed finish. The surfaces are sealed with several layers of water-based 'dead flat' decorating varnish, which protects the commode from spills and wear. The brass handles have been made from the 'lost wax' method, cast from originals that date from the the 19th century. The floral wallpaper shown on this commode is now extremely rare, so there is only one of this design available. However, we are able to source a variety of deadstock American wallpapers, so please get in touch if you would like to see further wallpapers designs, and commission a bespoke piece (6 week lead time).
