1920s Duchesse Brisee Day Bed

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Painted duchesse brisee, dating to the 1920s.

Duchesse brisee literally means 'broken duchess,' in reference to the fact that this day bed comes in three parts.

The name was issued by the French circa 1740, but the concept dates back to the ancient world.

This suite consists of two armchairs and an ottoman. The chairs have caned sides and seats, with sloping and scrolling armrests.

The frames of the chairs and ottoman have pretty painted decoration, in tones of green and gold. Each piece is supported on reeded tapering legs.

This suite comes with three beautiful tapestry and velvet cushions.

This lovely set is perfect for a morning room or conservatory setting, and can be used as originally intended or separated throughout a room.
