This is a stunning example of the iconic trumeau mirror, identified by a carved or painted panel of decoration to the top.

These mirrors originated in France during the 18th Century, intended to reflect more light into rooms whilst providing a decorative feature.

During this period these mirrors were a prominent element of architectural interior design.

The painted scene to this trumeau is particularly charming, depicting a Mediterranean fortified port and bay.

Beautiful gilding to mirror and panel frames, including the carved rosette so associated with Louis XVI.

Complimentary blue/ green paint makes this a really special piece that will command attention in an interior.
