Stunning 19th Century pollard oak breakfront bookcase.

Very much of neoclassical form, this bookcase is majestic, timeless and elegant.

The oak has been 'pollarded', whereby the tree is pruned to encourage dense branches and foliage, which in turn forms a burr.

When cut for veneer, this creates a swirling figure in the grain which is particularly visible in this piece.

Open shelves, the interior painted black, with decorative motifs to the supports. Sitting above four panelled doors with their original hardware.

Architectural flared cornice to the top. Adjustable shelves.
