A handsome and finely carved French mahogany daybed, stamped JACOB.

Georges Jacob (1739-1814) was one of the most prominent Parisian master ebenistes.

He specialised in carved and gilded beds and seat furniture for the French royal chateaux and also supplied furniture to George IV of England, Gustavus III of Sweden and several German princes.

Jacob was one of the first French cabinet makers to use mahogany extensively. After his retirement in 1796, he left his workshop in the hands of his sons.

When one of his sons died, Georges Jacob returned from retirement to oversee the supply of furnishings to Napoleon's residences.
