Gazing upward, the girl in the first painting has a most peaceful and confident countenance. She is holding her crook firmly, leading her charges through the 18th Century darkness. The sky is clearing above her as a reward for her faithfulness.

In the second canvas, the girl embraces the lamb as it emerges from the darkness. This is a beautiful pair of traditional, pastoral paintings.

One of the pieces is displaying craquelure and was re-lined quite some time ago; this needs to be done again.
