A rare and unusual pair of late 18th Century carved oak armchairs from the British Isles, possibly Welsh.

The most striking feature of this pair are the fantastically carved arm supports, in the form of hands with carved fingers gripping a spiral upright.

The decoration on this pair is extensive, demonstrating considerable attention to detail. The seat is carved with acorns and oak leaves, the back splat carved with unusual motifs of grapes and vines.

The personal history and craftsmanship behind this pair of chairs will bring warmth and character to any interior setting.
