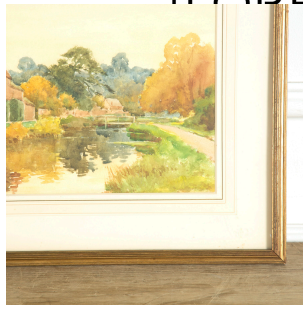
Original watercolour painting of the Lower Slaughters area of the Cotswolds, by Henry John Sylvester Stannard.

Stannard (1870-1951) descended from a family of well-known Bedfordshire artists. He often painted pastoral scenes and the rural idyll. He exhibited at the Royal Academy, the Royal Institute of Painters in Water Colours, the New Gallery, the Royal Society of British Artists, and the Royal Cambrian Academy of Art.

In 1906, Stannard was honoured by Queen Alexandra and she commissioned a number of works from him, including *Wild Garden and Woods* at Sandringham.
