Early 19th Century large pine Scottish breakfront bookcase.

Reputed to be by Trollope & Sons, who were one of the most significant makers of furniture during the reign of Queen Victoria.

The 19th Century was a period of many revivals in design and Trollope adapted their pieces accordingly.

This magnificent bookcase shows the influence of the Gothic Revival taking place in England at the time, with the hooded arches that decorate the outside of the glass.

Each of the three sections has its own door, opening to reveal four shelves in each. With column supports and an architectural cornice.

Painted red to the inside, this bookcase offers plenty of storage and a stunning feature in any interior.
