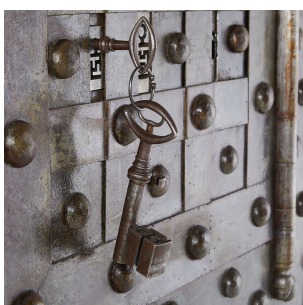

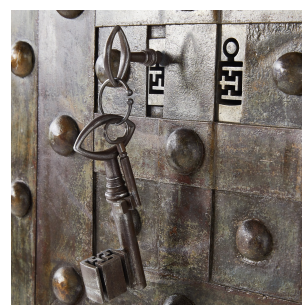
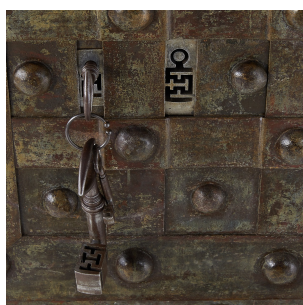

A mid 19th Century French wrought iron hobnail studded safe by Magaud De Charf. Of good size. Would make a stunning feature piece as a drinks, storage cabinet etc... This important Gothic style safe was manufactured by Magaud de Charf in Marseilles, France (1850-1890), and features a nailhead design on all four sides with its all-original working mechanism. The front door is further decorated with two large hinges on the sides. The inside opens to reveal an amazing lock mechanism and a large storage compartment. To open the safe, you first need to find and locate the nail which will activate and open the key latch on the right. Then, by inserting the smaller of the three keys half-way, it will open both left key latches at once. Next, place the two large keys in each key hole one at a time.
