Large pair of 19th Century, buff terracotta garden urns by James Pulham of Broxbourne.

James Pulham & Son was one of the most important landscape design firms, operating between 1845 and 1949. They received royal warrants for their work on lakes at both the Sandringham Estate and Buckingham Palace.

These urns have a bead and reel top edge, above a bold acanthus border, going down to the wonderfully bulbous gadrooned body with large acanthus handles, the whole standing on its original extended socle.

In generally good condition, with a couple of losses to the socles edging and repairs to the handles.
