Park was born in Lancashire but moved to St. Ives in 1899. He studied under Julius Olsson and at Atelier Colarossi in Paris.

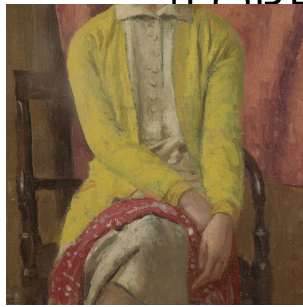
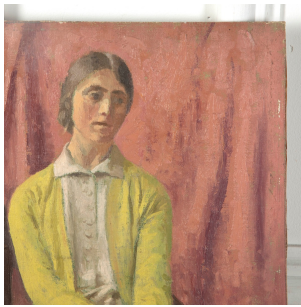
