This seat could be used as a window seat or in a hallway and is a great example of the Hollywood Regency style which embodied glamour.

Hollywood Regency emerged in the 1930s to bring star quality to film sets. Most famous is the house of actress Joan Crawford, who is played by Faye Dunaway in 'Mommy Dearest.'

Clearly influenced by ancient Greek shapes, this stylish seat has scrolling armrests and legs.

It also exemplifies both Art Deco and Mid-Century modern trends, in the carved detailing, clean lines and floral motifs.

This ebonised seat is typical of the Hollywood Regency preference for a monochrome colour palette and lacquering pieces of furniture.
