Harlequin set of six late 19th Century English dining chairs.

All the chairs feature horizontal splats joined by spindle turned uprights, some slanting inwards.

These chairs have dipped seats to hold a cushion and turned front legs and stretchers.

Provincial craftsmen often used locally-available wood which was more affordable and this was usually fruitwood. This set has a lovely authentic patina.

These furniture makers rarely made a whole set of chairs in the same design and this set may have been added to over the years as a family grew in size.

A very charming set of country dining chairs.
