The design of the Superleggera chair was inspired by the traditional and very simple vernacular chairs produced in the Ligurian town of Chiavari.

A highly recognisable design, this chair is an icon of Italian post-war design and the country's craft. The Superleggera chair has a timeless aesthetic which blends seamlessly into interiors.
