Double-sided pub sign from the Victoria Inn, Salcombe.

This sign was created for the St. Austell brewery by their resident sign writer, Andrew Grundon.

The sign hung for many years outside the Victoria Inn, Fore Street, from the 1990s through the early 2000s. Salcombe is a charming sailing town in Devon.

The sign depicts the pub's namesake, the HMS Victoria. The ship was the last British wooden first-rate, three-decked ship of the line commissioned for sea service.

She was the largest wooden battleship to ever enter service, and the world's largest warship until the creation of the HMS Warrior in 1861.
