The bodies feature unusual pierced architectural carving, with gadrooned collars. Lovely blue and white paint adds to the aesthetic appeal of this pair.

Corbels were a major feature of any Victorian home, and wood and plaster examples are suitable for indoor settings.

These are the perfect accent to bring more of a period feel into your home, and would look especially eye-catching lit up from the inside to highlight the intricately pierced carvings.

Possible settings for this pair of corbels range from the kitchen, to below a window seat, to either side of the fireplace.
