The ebonised frame and gilt banding gives it the appearance of bamboo. Resting on splayed legs.

This piece is in the style of E.W. Godwin, who is credited with popularising Anglo-Japanese style.

The Aesthetic Movement (1860-1890) celebrated art for art's sake, and was a conscious movement away from the ugliness of the industrial age.

This is a unique and attractive piece, suitable for a range of purposes and settings.
