These chairs were designed by the Viennese Secessionist architect Otto Wagner in 1903. Model No. 714.

These smart ebonised chairs have geometrically pierced backrests. They have great sleek and smart form and will be a wonderful addition to any space.

Both chairs are stamped and numbered by the manufacturer Kohn & Kohn. One has remains of its original paper label, bearing the trademark (intertwined letters K&K) motto "Semper Sursum" (obscured), and inscribed Jacob & Josef Kohn, Wien, Registrirte Shutzmarke.
