The undulating chair backs have three scalloped horizontal splats, including the top rail which features a central carved shell flanked with simple floral motifs. These carved details are repeated to the prominent aprons.

Resting on pronounced cabriole legs which terminate in upturned scroll feet and are connected by a turned H-stretcher.

These chairs offer a charming dining set for any interior, with their combination of provincial aesthetic and quality design.
