Irish cockfighting chair by Williams & Gibton, circa 1830.

This beautiful chair is complete with its original carved and pierced yoke rail with a very decorative cross leaf design. It also retains a restored under-seat drawer.

It is supported on elegant cabriole legs with hoof feet concealing fully swivelling castors. The tops of the chair legs exhibit primitive hand-carving.

There are no tears to the wonderful oxblood leather upholstery, just one slight indentation.

This is a truly beautiful piece that exhibits the finest craftsmanship. Williams & Gibton of Dublin were one of the most renowned cabinet-making firms in early 19th Century Ireland.
