This large bowl is of superb quality. It is designed to capture and reflect candlelight for a truly dazzling display.

It features a scalloped rim and the unusual pedestal base has applied cut lozenges on the flat.

This bowl is in good overall condition, with only a few minor nibbles around the rim commensurate with its age. Ireland's glass industry took off in the 18th Century, and the best glassmakers in England and Ireland created exquisite glassware known as Anglo-Irish glass.

This stunning bowl would look wonderful filled with fruit or flowers on a dining table, or for use as a small punch bowl.
