Wonderful collection of Mid Century purple Wedgwood glassware, designed by Ronald Stennett-Willson. Circa 1970.

This set comprises candlestick holders, candlesticks and a vase. The deep purple colour lends these pieces a luxurious opulence.

Ronald Stennett-Willson (1915-2009) is known as one of the great British glass designers of the 20th Century. His career is perhaps best remembered for his iconic 'Sheringham' candlestick, which earned him the Queen's Award for industry.

He then became Managing Director and Chief Designer of Wedgwood Glass, where he stayed until his retirement in 1979.

Willson's work influenced the likes of Caithness Glass and Dartington Glass, with a profound impact on the industry.
