This statue is missing his head and arms, but was likely made after the iconic ancient Greek statue of Discobolus. The original Discobolus of Myron was completed around 460-450 BC and depicts the young male athlete throwing a discus.

Mounted on a plinth base.

In its incomplete form this statue is even more striking and it will make for a fantastic decorative feature.
