These highly decorative prints are in very good condition and presented in contemporary frames.

Martinet (1725-1804) was a prolific French court artist and engraver. He is remembered for his extensive contribution to George Louis Leclerc Buffon's major work *Histoire Naturelle, Générale et Particulière.*

Martinet provided all of the bird illustrations for the work, which were also published separately in *Histoire Naturelle des Oiseaux*.

The work was a resounding success and a bestseller of its day, translated into many different languages.
