The concentric veneered circular top is supported on four very substantial legs, with great colour throughout.

This majestic table is a very large example of its type, measuring 204cm when open. The patent mechanism which allows it to expand is known as Liegnitzer Ringtish (Ring Table). The mechanism is in perfect working order.

The decorative top has been refinished, with wear consistent with age that only adds to its wonderful aged appearance.

Closed, the diameter is 144 cm, and comfortably seats 6. Open it can easily accommodate 10.
