The addition of these super expensive legs would have been part of a custom order, which is also suggested by the seat rails incorporating parrot heads and the feathered legs with ball-and-claw feet.

This chair would have been double the price of the standard chairs in Howard's original trade price list.

Howard & Sons, established in 1820, were renowned as the best in upholstered furniture during the 19th Century. Their designs, which combine ultimate comfort with an iconic aesthetic, are still highly coveted today.
