Rare early 19th Century English marquetry picture by J. H. Grigg.

This picture is in the Swiss style and consists of over 300 pieces of inlaid woods. The scene depicts a country house in the Highlands.

This piece has two labels on the back. The first states: 'A residence in the Highlands where His Majesty entertained the different clans, who went through their games. Mechanical picture containing three hundred pieces of wood, made by J.H. Grigg.'

The second reads, 'Patronised by his Grace The Duke of Wellington.'

This picture is in unrestored, untouched condition. There are some cracks and lifting to the veneers. Warped back boards and minor losses to the frame. However it is stable and secure and still a fascinating and decorative piece.
