Wonderful set of English oak Arts & Crafts armchairs, designed by Gordon Russell. Dating to the early 20th Century.

These chairs comprise 10 standard chairs and two armchairs. The dimensions listed apply to the standard chairs.

Each has a rectilinear tapering back with vertical splats. Resting on simple square legs with supporting stretchers.

The seats are upholstered in linen.

The singles measure: H:44cm, D: 39cm, W: 49cm. The armchairs are more generous but the same height.

Gordon Russell (1892-1980) was a prolific figure in the Arts & Crafts movement. He set up a base in Chipping Campden with a desire to create furniture that improved people's lives and could be valued for generations.

The result is honest and functional furniture with timeless appeal. This set will look brilliant in period and contemporary interiors alike.
