Wonderful Spanish 19th Century folk art butcher's bench, from the Pyrenees area.

Centuries of weathering have naturally bleached this bench to a wonderful pale colour.

These benches were used in the butchery and preparation of wild boar, hence their low stature.

This example is deeply grooved and warped all over, giving it immense character.

The top is formed from one solid trunk of hardwood, with two sides bolted to it. Its condition is entirely original other than some sympathetic repairs to the legs.

This bench has a wonderful vernacular aesthetic. It could also work well as a rustic low side table in today's home.
