This plate has wonderful detail which is typical of Chinese-influenced tableware; produced in Holland.

Featuring floral paintwork, inferring that it may be a garden or a sanctuary scene.

There was a great change in dining habits during the 18th Century which meant that coffee and tea culture in Europe demanded the production of porcelain. The Chinese quickly responded to this and began to produce new designs that were shipped across Europe.

This plate would have been one of many, however, this does not detract from its charm.

It will be a wonderful addition to any country house or contemporary setting.
