Surreal and psychedelic, the lyrics and illustrations reflect the mood of the 60s and show what an immense influence the greatest band of all time had on the style of their generation and those that followed.

These prints retain all the style of the originals and are a must for any Beatles fan or anyone interested in design or the social history of the 60s.

Depicting the lyrics from hit songs such as Helter Skelter, Tomorrow Never Knows, I don't want to Spoil a Party and What goes on by Alan Aldridge and Give Peace a Chance By Harry Willcock.
