The city of Tabriz in the North West region of Persia has been a major centre of rug weaving since the 14th Century and as heir to such a long tradition, no other rug-producing region in Persia can claim such a wide array of designs or pattern types.

This circa 1940 Tabriz carpet has creative design characteristics of earlier weavings of the 18th century. The spacious (or large) scale drawing introduces a hint of fanciful creativity that suggests carefree spontaneity, framed by a wide ivory border.
