Pair of vintage chairs, designed by Frantisek Navratil. Circa 1950s.

These chairs exhibit classic Mid Century style throughout. They are low slung with incorporated armrests and an open lower back.

Supported on splayed tapering legs and joined with a cross-stretcher. These chairs have been recovered in a textured purple fabric.

Navratil designed these chairs for production by Tatra in the Czech Republic.

These chairs were presented at the Brussels 'Expo 58' exhibition in 1958. After two devastating world wars, this exhibition represented a vision for the future. It was a world fair, attracting immense international attention.

This pair represent refined and stylish post-war design, and would make a great addition to a living room or home office.
