A large scale 19th Century French trumeau wall mirror.

Trumeau mirrors, meaning 'pier glass,' originated in 18th Century France and refer to mirrors set into tall wooden frames. They feature a large section of carved or sculptural decoration to the top.

This mirror has decorative shell and garland mouldings to the later painted frame.

Trumeaus were the essence of architectural interior design during the 18th Century, intended to add a reflective element to the wall which would allow additional light into a room.

Their popularity endured and they are still a beautiful item to have in the home today.
