Louis XVI mahogany four drawer commode. Circa 1790.

This lovely commode retains its original statuary marble top, and delicately pierced gallery.

Featuring beautifully faded veneers and lovely, understated original brass mounts and handles.

This is a more elaborate model than most commodes during this period, as the four long graduated drawers are flanked by free-standing columns either side.

The columns are surrounded by brass capitals, with projecting brass panelled blocks above.

Of particular note on this piece are the fine toupie feet.

This is an elegant and finely proportioned commode, of simple classical design.
