Made in Italy for the Parisien design atelier Mercier Frères.

Established in 1828, Mercier Frères was a furniture and tapestry making company in 19th Century France. They supplied furniture to the Spanish and Iranian courts amongst other high-profile clients.

Whilst most of their furniture had been made in the Louis XV and Louis XVI styles, by the 20th Century Mercier Frères was highly influenced by Art Deco style.

This pair of mirrors are made from brass and chrome and reflect the much more contemporary style that the firm evolved over time. Circa 1970.
